ANGOLA LODGE #236 BUILDING NEARING 100 YEARS OLD

Construction of the current Angola Masonic Lodge building began on April 1, 1923, the cornerstone laid on August 21, 1923, and the building dedicated on St. Johns Day on June 24, 1924. At the time of the dedication, Angola Lodge had a membership of 616.

To celebrate the buildings 100 years of existance, a special coin has been struck to help commemorate the 100 year building. You can purchase the coin for \$10.00 from a local member.



FOUND 1924 ANGOLA PAPER OF NEW BUILDING DEDICATION

On June 25, 1924 the Angola Steuben Republican described the dedication of the new Masonic Building in Angola. Through cutting and pasting the front page has been reconstructed on a foam board for interested Masons to read. A photo below shows the reconstruction of the front page. It will be available during a celebration later this year.

The article describes the day's program and how the building will become a community center for events to take place in the future. It will describe the key leaders of the Masonic Lodge, York Rite and Eastern Star that made the building a reality.



I know that you cannot read the print but wanted to demonstrate what the front page looked like 100 years ago.

The page will be on display when a celebration of the 100th anniversary of the building will be held later this year.

An impressive ceremony was held by the Grand Lodge and local Masons in the social room. There were orations, music and recognition of those who made the event possible.

In 1924 there were 585 dues paying Masons, 331 York Rite Masons and 291 in the Order of the Eastern Star, all of which used this beautiful Masonic Temple.

100TH CELEBRATION OF THE ANGOLA MASONIC BUILDING

An event to celebrate the 100th Birthday is being planned. The Lodge will have an open house, a celebration with representatives of the Grand Lodge and displays. The exact time schedule has not been formulated, but the Lodge Officers will plan a special day.

The public will be invited to see the building and be able to observe the pictures of the Angola Past Masters which has recently been placed on the south side of the dining room hall.

There is a fee of \$150.00 to petition and once voted on, degree work will proceed, starting with the introductory or 4th degree. One must take a required set of 5 degrees ending with the 32nd degree. Once one receives the 32nd degree you are an official Scottish Rite member. Many degrees will be available on a Scottish Rite website in the future.

A Master Mason in good standing can join Scottish Rite on Saturday, April 22 during the one day class to join Blue Lodge, Scottish Rite and/or Shrine. Please inquire about the procedure to join. A petition must be submitted.

THURSDAY NIGHT AT THE RITE

Scottish Rite degrees can be obtained through this program (at home on your computer). The first in the series were held in January, February and March. Two more degrees will be presented in this fashion. Once your petition is accepted, you will be given a code to enable for you to watch the degrees. The last of the presentations of the series will be on:

April 13 – 21st degree – Patriarch Noachite April 19 – 20th degree – Master ad Vitam

To join Scottish Rite, contact the Scottish Rite Office (or Paul Friend) on the procedure to register for the degrees. You must present a petition. Once the petition is accepted, you will be able to connect with the computer presentations (special procedure to enroll is necessary).

NIGHT OF HOPE AND INSPIRATION – APRIL 29


