

# BENJAMIN DAWSON MASTER OF ANGOLA LODGE # 236 in 1860



Benjamin Dawson became Worshipful Master of Angola Lodge in 1860, serving immediately after Jesse Squire, who served the Charter year of the Lodge in 1858 and a second year in 1959. Benjamin served as Master in 1860, 1872, 1873, 1876,1879, 1880, and 1881.

His picture was found in an 1800's Angola paper. Benjamin operated a general merchandise store in Angola and was a highly respected businessman.

### **SEARCH FOR PAST MASTER FAMILIES CONTINUES!!**

On New Years' Eve, 23 new Past Master pictures were added to the dining room wall. YES 23!! This was a result of work the past 3 months as many helped identify families to help find needed pictures.

There are now only 24 pictures to be found. A total of 98 are now in place. We have had 122 different Past Masters since the Lodge was chartered in 1858. I was able to find the great granddaughter of Sylvester Fitch, who was Master for 10 years from 1861-1870.

Need your help! I have no clue on where to find some of the early Masters. For example, Jesse Squire in 1858; Simeon Latson in 1874; Otto Schultz in 1884; Fred Snyder in 1897; Clyde Ritter in 1909; Earl Dole in1921; Kenneth Rathbun in 1927; Wayland Seely in 1937. WHO OUT THERE WORKS WITH ANCESTRY ON YOUR COMPUTER? I have not used it yet but understand it can give a person some leads. WHO CAN HELP TO FIND ANY TYPE OF CLUE? HELP SEARCH AND SEE WHAT YOU CAN FIND!

A more recent Past Master – JOHN (JACK) JOHNSON? 1952.

According to the old Angola papers, Jack was involved with a Real Estate firm known as Tri-State Improvement, located at 214 West Maumee. He was Worshipful Master in 1952 and helped organize the 1958 100th Anniversary of the Lodge. He may have worked with brother Jerry Ralston. He had a daughter Pat Johnson, who married the son of Leonard Bearman. Leonard was Past Master in 1959.

### **NEXT VALLEY EVENTS - STATED MEETINGS**

January 10 is the next Scottish Rite stated meeting to be held at the Ft. Wayne Scottish Rite building. Dinner will be at 6:15 PM with meeting to follow. If you are a candidate they will do the first essential degree (4<sup>th</sup>) starting at 5:45 PM.

### INVITATION TO JOIN SCOTTISH RITE

Any Master Mason is encouraged to join Scottish Rite. One must petition the Ft. Wayne Valley through a current Scottish Rite member. There is a fee of \$150.00 to petition and once voted on, degree work will proceed, starting with the introductory or 4<sup>th</sup> degree. One must take a required set of 5 degrees ending with the 32<sup>nd</sup> degree. Once one receives the 32<sup>nd</sup> degree you are an official Scottish Rite member. Many degrees will be available on a Scottish Rite website in the future.

### THURSDAY NIGHT AT THE RITE

Scottish Rite degrees can be obtained through this program. On January 19<sup>th</sup> the 20 degree will be presented on your computer at home. On February 2 the 8<sup>th</sup> degree will be presented and on February 16 the 5<sup>th</sup>. A total of 6 degrees will be presented in this fashion.

Contact the Scottish Rite Office (or Paul Friend) on the way to register for the degrees. You must present a petition to be able to join Scottish Rite, then take the above degrees.

### SCOTTISH RITE SCHOLARSHIPS AVAILABLE NOW!!

The ABBOTT SCHOLARSHIP is available with the following qualifications:

- 1) Must be from a family with a Mason in good standing
- 2) Be a High School Senior minimum 2.75 grade average out of 4.00
- 3) A student from a deceased Mason is eligible
- 4) Application due May 1, 2023

The NURSING SCHOLARSHIP is available with the following qualifications:

- 1) Student enrolled in a nursing program.
- 2) Graduate of a High School in Ft. Wayne Scottish Valley County
- 3) Demonstrate need.
- 4) Family does not need to be connected to family member in Masonry.
- 5) Application due March 1, 2023.




# MIZPAH SHRINE CIRCUS IS SET FOR FRIDAY, JANUARY 27, 2023
