#### **ANGOLA MONUMENT (MOUND)**

This monthly newsletter will include comments of one of the main attractions of Angola. It is a reminder of reasons we celebrate Memorial Day. This includes the many men from Steuben County who served our Country.





#### ANGOLA MONUMENT HISTORY

Located in the Northeast corner of the state of Indiana, Angola is the County Seat of Steuben County. Angola was founded in June of 1838 by Thomas Gale and Cornelius Gilmore and is the home to Trine University. The population was 8,612 at the 2010 census.

Downtown Angola's traffic circle (or roundabout-- nicknamed "The Mound"), looking east. The monument in the center is dedicated to those who served in the American Civil War. The building with the cupola is the Steuben County courthouse, which is on the National Register of Historic Places.

The most popular landmark in Angola is the Monument, referred to by locals as "The Mound" or the 'Circle.' Built in 1917 by E.M. Heltzer, The Monument commemorates the Civil War. It has statues for all four branches of the military. On top is the statue of Columbia, facing east. It cost \$17,000 in 1917, over \$1,000,000 if it were built today. The Monument is the center of many town celebrations and festivities. It was unveiled on Thursday, September 13, 1917 at 1PM to much fanfare. On the Monument are plaques with the names of the 1,278 men from Steuben County who fought in the war. Per capita, more men from Steuben County enlisted for the war than any other county in Indiana. The monument underwent a renovation in 1993 and was re-dedicated during Fourth of July ceremonies.

A. J. Snyder was a member of Angola Masonic Lodge #236, serving as Worshipful Master in 1883. He was the driving force to raise funds for the Angola Monument, which was erected in 1917, as reported in the Angola newspaper.

He was a veteran of the Civil War and has his name proudly displayed at the monument, along with several other prominent Masons.

American Legion Post #31 was responsible for the Memorial Day program at the Angola monument on May 27. Matthew Wignall, Commander of Post #31, whose picture shown below, was pictured in the Angola Herald Republican (below), during the program. Matthew is a member of Angola Masonic Lodge #236.

I am sure there are numerous other Veterans who are members of local Masonic Lodges. We thank them for their service in days past and for their continued dedication in today's world.

#### POKAGON MEAT RAFFLE TO CONTINUE IN 2024


