Each state has some differences in the tactics of each of the degrees and orders, which makes observing degrees very enjoyable. The lessons presented remain the same in each one.

The classes are normally 20 to 30 candidates in size, with the largest class having 57 candidates in 2010, when John McNaughton, Sovereign Grand Commander of the Northern Masonic Jurisdiction, Scottish Rite, was honored.

Special thanks go this year to the three State Coordinators who do much of the organizational work, including Mike Anderson of Indiana, Ken Crouch of Ohio and Donald Trumbull of Michigan. A large number of current and past Grand Officer and officers in the local York Rite bodies also contributed significantly.


