Through the efforts of several Lodge Officers, especially Brant Moore, money was sought and received to replace the back door of the Lodge building. This exit door is located on the northeast side of the building and is the original door placed when the building was completed in 1924. For safety reasons the door will be replaced so it meets the requirements of building codes, especially a workable bar to allow people to exit safely.

If you have never looked above the door you will note “No. 236 F and AM” engraved in the limestone. Also note the Arch and the intricate design. A masterpiece designed by the Masons in the early 1920’s.

Monies were received from a combination of the City of Angola, York Rite and donations from current and past members.

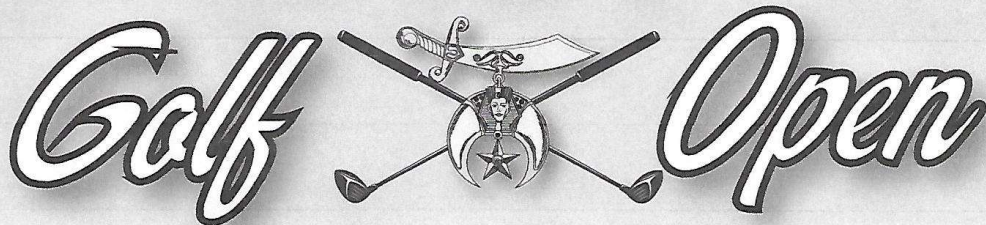

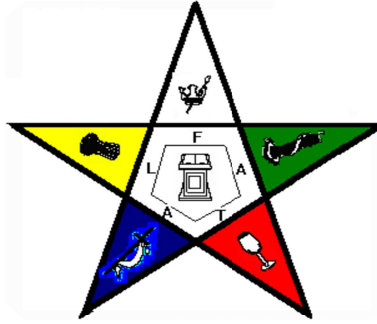
