Richard Ruselink of Angola, a 46 year Mason was recognized by the Grand Lodge of Indiana as the recipient of the Order of Service to Masonry. The Service award is given to Masons who conform to the Ancient Landmarks of the fraternity and has set an example of serving Masonry and his community. Richard joined Angola Masonic Lodge #236 in 1977, serving as Worshipful Master in 1981. His service to Angola Lodge was best known by serving as Secretary of Angola Lodge for 25 years, a task that encompasses detailed record keeping and hours of required recording and correspondence.

Richards' ritual work was outstanding as he could recite some of the largest lectures by memory and was able to assist in many officer roles during degree work. He faithfully attended the Indiana Grand Lodge meetings and assisted local Masonic Lodges to assist in degree work.

In Masonry he is also a member of Angola York Rite, Ft. Wayne Valley of Scottish Rite and Mizpah Shrine. In Shrine, he was the Bagpipe Major of the Shrine Bagpipers for several years and would be found leading several bagpipe members in northeast Indiana parades, including the July 4<sup>th</sup> parade.

Richard was a professor in the Mathematics and Computer Services

Department of Tri-State University for 18 years. Richard also coached Little

League baseball, was a CASA volunteer, served on the Sheriff's Merit Board

and was on the Steuben County Property Tax Assessment Board of Appeals
for 15 years.


# MIZPAH SHRINE STATED MEETING HELD AT ANGOLA LODGE ON OCTOBER 4
