Angola Masonic Lodge No. 236, located on the southeast quadrant of the Public Square, was chartered in 1858, and thus has been in existence for nearly 170 years. Hundreds of local men have been members over the years.

The current building of the Masons, built

in 1924, recently celebrated its location in downtown Angola for 100 years.

Any man, aged 18 or more are eligible to join the Masons. There are four Masonic Lodges in Steuben County which includes Angola, Orland, Fremont and Ashley. Inquiries can be made to any member or officer of these Lodges, through Facebook or google searches.


POKAGON SHRINE STATED MEETING
